

Artistic Experience

The MFA. musician **Wolfgang Huhn** has performed all the important trumpet compositions by composers such as Bach and Handel successfully. He is self-employed and he is solo trumpeter of the Frankfurt Symphony Orchestra (*Frankfurter Sinfoniker*) and the Johann Strauss Orchestra Frankfurt (*Johann-Strauß-Orchester Frankfurt*). He worked on many recordings as a soloist, for example, he worked for the hr (Hessischer Rundfunk) Radio and TV Broadcast and CD recordings of baroque music and the music from opera, operetta, musicals and light music. He has also held solo concerts with accompaniment of organ or orchestra for several times in France, Italy (*Pasqua Musicale Arcense*) and China (Trumpet-Concerto of Haydn with the *China National Symphony Orchestra* in the *National Center for the Performing Arts NCPA* and with baroque music in the *Forbidden City Concert Hall* of Beijing).

Wolfgang Huhn studied from Otto Wenke, the solo trumpeter of the Frankfurt Opera. He graduated from the University for Music and Performing Arts in Frankfurt am Main in the major of "artistic education for orchestra musicians" with "very good" and acquired the degree of Master of Fine Arts.

Then he visited courses of Thomas Stevens, Carole Dawn Reinhart, Roger Delmotte as well as Pierre Thibaud and many private lessons which were given by Bo Nilsson for a few years.

He studied baroque trumpet from Edward H. Tarr and Michael Laird. Later he graduated very successfully from a one-year baroque trumpet study at the Sweelinck Conservatory in Amsterdam which was taught by Prof. Friedemann Immer.

Critics praise always his trumpet-playings as musical, sensitive and yet brilliant and stylish.

Wolfgang Huhn works as a lecturer at Dalberg High Middle School (Dalberg-Gymnasium) in Aschaffenburg and at the Städtische Musikschule Aschaffenburg, the oldest music school in Germany.
